HOMILY

THE PROFESSION OF FAITH

dead, and his kingdom will
have no end.*

*We believe in the Holy Spirit,
the Lord, the giver of life,
who proceeds from the Father*

he is worshipped and
glorified, he has spoken
through the Prophets.*

We acknowledge one baptism
for the forgiveness of sins.
We look for the resurrection
of the dead, and the life of

EUCHARISTIC PRAYER II

P: Father, it is our duty and
our salvation, always and

you made the universe, the

Saviour you sent to redeem
us.

By the power of the Holy
Spirit he took flesh and was
born of the Virgin Mary.

For our sake he opened his
arms on the cross; he put an
end to death and revealed the
resurrection.

In this he fulfilled your will
and won for you a holy
people.

And so we join the angels and
the saints in proclaiming your
glory as we sing (say):

again; bring them and all the
departed into the light of your
presence. Have mercy on us
all: make us worthy to share
eternal life, with Mary, the
virgin mother of God, with the
apostles, and with all the
saints who have done your
will throughout the ages.
May we praise you in union
with them, and give you glory
through your Son, Jesus
Christ.

Through him, with him,
in him, in the unity of the

Holy Spirit, all glory and
honour is yours, almighty
Father, for ever and ever.

R: *Amen.*

EUCCHARISTIC PRAYER III

P: Father, you are holy
indeed, and all creation
rightly gives you praise.
All life, all holiness comes
from you through your Son,
Jesus Christ our Lord, by the
working of the Holy Spirit.
From age to age you gather
a people to yourself, so that
from east to west a perfect
offering may be made to the
glory of your name.

And so, Father, we bring you
these gifts.

We ask you to make them
holy by the power of your

the day or the patron saint)

constant intercession we rely
for help.

Lord, may this sacrifice, which
has made our peace with you,
advance the peace and
salvation of all the world.
Strengthen in faith and love
your pilgrim Church on earth;
your servant, Pope **N.**, our
bishop **N.**, and all the bishops,
with the clergy and the entire
people your Son has gained
for you.

Father, hear the prayers of
the family you have gathered
here before you.

In mercy and love unite all your children wherever they may be.

Welcome into your kingdom our departed brothers and sisters, and all who have left this world in your friendship.

We hope to enjoy for ever the vision of your glory, through Christ our Lord, from whom all good things come.

Through him, with him, in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor is yours, almighty Father, for ever and ever.

RITE OF COMMUNION

P: Let us pray with confidence to the Father in the words our Saviour gave us:

PATER NOSTER

T: *Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.*

Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

P: Deliver us, Lord, from every evil, and grant us peace in our day.

In your mercy keep us free from sin and protect us from all anxiety as we wait in joyful hope for the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ.

R: *For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours, now and forever.*

P: Lord Jesus Christ, you said to your apostles: "I leave you peace, my peace I give you", look not on our sins, but on the faith of your Church, and grant us the peace and unity of your kingdom where you live for ever and ever.
